lays successive coats of plaster or rendering and fixes fibrous plaster such as mould cornices and wall pattern

installs and repairs heating, venting, and air conditioning systems.

erects wood frames, fits joints, fixes wood floors, stairs and window frames; builds and dismantles wood or metal formwork

installs, maintains, and repairs electrical systems in both residential and commercial spaces.

puts in elevators, escalators, and other moving walkways and stairs, and also maintains and repairs them.
