## Hair coloring OMBRE.

Translated from the French word "Ombre" means "shadow". the technique of coloring the Ombre on short hair and long hair has become a real world trend, this can be seen by looking at the stars of the movie defiling along the red paths – many of them nowadays do themselves coloring the Ombre (on blond hair, dark and even red).

Ombre on the hair is a transition from a dark color at the roots to a lighter color at the tips. Shades of colors can be any.

In the vast majority of cases, Ombre is a brightening staining. The roots remain in a natural color, and the tips are painted in a light tone.

To Ombre looked good, it is very important to choose the right shade. Usually the color should be a couple of tones lighter than your natural color.

Brown-haired women for Ombre should consider different shades of blonde. Now especially popular cold colors-ash or platinum blonde.

Brunettes should look at the copper shades. Rich red is now out of fashion, but the noble copper composite color will look very important.

The most difficult to pick up a shade for Ombre happens to girls with light hair. Pick up the color is a little lighter, warm or cold colors, depending on your hair color.

Types of colour "Ombre»

Classic Ombre-the effect of sun-burnt hair. The original is darker shades at the roots and bronze-bright at the ends.

**Fire Ombre (flames)** - this option is more youth and catchy. In this kind of mandatory colors are red and red. It is important that the shades were bright and create a feeling that the hair emits fire.

The reverse Ombre - the idea of the reverse look is that it is the opposite of classic and vintage styles. At the roots of the hair light and ends dark. Smooth transition is not important. This kind of well suited blondes.
